She was accepted to the prestigious Elmhurst School in association with Birmingham Royal Ballet where she continued her training until her graduation in 2010. Ms. Muratov accepted a position at Ballet de l'Opera National de Bordeaux in France where she has had the opportunity to tour Europe and China. Jared Matthews was born in Houston and received his early ballet training there under the guidance of Victoria Vittum and Gilbert Rome. Mr. Matthews joined American Ballet Theatre as an apprentice in 2002 and as a member of the corps de ballet in 2003. He was appointed a Soloist in 2007. Mr. Matthews joined Houston Ballet as a first soloist in 2014, and was promoted to the rank of principal dancer in 2015. Mr. Matthews performed with us as the dashing Cavalier in *The Nutcracker* and we are overjoyed to welcome him back as Franz in *Coppélia*.
